


## Preparedness Leaders





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
# Status Report Impact on Access to Dental Care?



# Status Report Impact on Oral Health Status?






A national disaster relief agreement among 48 states, District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands

#### Recovery Surveillance – December 2005



### Anticipated Actions (Needs)

#### Convene local community planning

- Require oral health indicators in community needs assessments?
- Engage the local dental workers in local response teams?
- Leadership training to coordinate volunteers and logistics (mass care)
- Facilitate forensic odontology (DMORT) operations
  - Locate and retrieve anti-mortum dental records?
- Engage dentists in training for immunizations, replenish prescriptions, triage or other primary health services
- Convene state dental association and dental education administrators in statewide emergency planning operations (currently allopathic only)
