

Welcome to MSIS: Medicaid/CHIP Statistical Information System

Beginning with FY 1999, the Balanced Budget Act (BBA) of 1997 requires states to submit all their eligibility and claims data to CMS on a quarterly basis through the Medicaid Statistical Information System (MSIS). States submit individual eligibility data and claims files to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) in five file formats: 1)Eligibility along with 4 types of claims files: 1) RX, 2) Inpatient, 3) Long Term Care and 4) Other Services. The Federal requirement for the HCFA-2082 form was eliminated.



Welcome to MSIS: Medicaid/CHIP Statistical Information System cont'd

- Currently MSIS is made available to the public (WEB) once a full FISCAL YEAR is approved and at least 10 states for given FISCAL YEAR are available
- An ongoing criticism of MSIS was that the information was dated and incomplete (MC and CHIP)
- With the advent of CHIPRA, Health Reform, ARRA, CMS is in the midst of "redefining" its Information System
- CMS will need to collect more data and share more of its information faster and with more ease




Welcome to MSIS: Medicaid/CHIP Statistical Information System cont'd

- CMS will need to receive all separate CHIP data (eligibility as well as claims) from all 50 States plus the District of Columbia
- CMS will need to receive ALL Encounter Data from all States/DC with Managed Care Plans


Adding First Dimension






EPSDT ENROLLEES subset by DENTAL Service Type




View of Unique Eligibles/Enrollees by Program Type











Fee For Service Dental by AGE Groups




Fee For Service Dental by Age Group




Encounters Subset by Dental Services









MONTHLY ELIGIBLITY CUBE
