


# West Virginia Medicaid

- Cost associated with expansion
  - Potentially add up to 170,000 new clients
  - ▶ Estimated that States will spend \$63 million from 2013 − 2023




- ▶ Issues:
  - Benefit Confusion
  - Access to Care



#### Benefit Confusion

- Dental insurance plans include a wide variety of coverage
  - ► Recent Consumer Survey Results
    - □ Nearly one third (31%) do not know what their deductible is
    - □ 43% believe their dental insurance only covers "some" or "a few" of their needs
    - □ The vast majority (79%) say their dental insurance covers preventive services; I in 5 say "no" or "don't know"




- Additional Benefit Confusion
  - Uncertainty of what Marketplace or Exchange really is or how it works
  - ▶ Enrollment complications




### Access to Care

#### Distribution of Dentists



Oral / Maxillofacial Surgery	6 %	Prosthodontics	1 %
Pediatric Dentistry	3 %	Other	1 %
Endodontics	3 %	Oral / Maxillofacial Radiology	0 %
Periodontics	2 %	Blank	7 %

- Access to Care
  - Insurance Acceptance
    - Currently only 32% of dentist accept Adult Medicaid for Emergencies

  - Broken appointments




### **Dental Providers**

- Work with Medicaid and providers to ensure system in place to assure fair reimbursement
- Mork with stakeholders to incorporate case management/ care coordination into State programs
