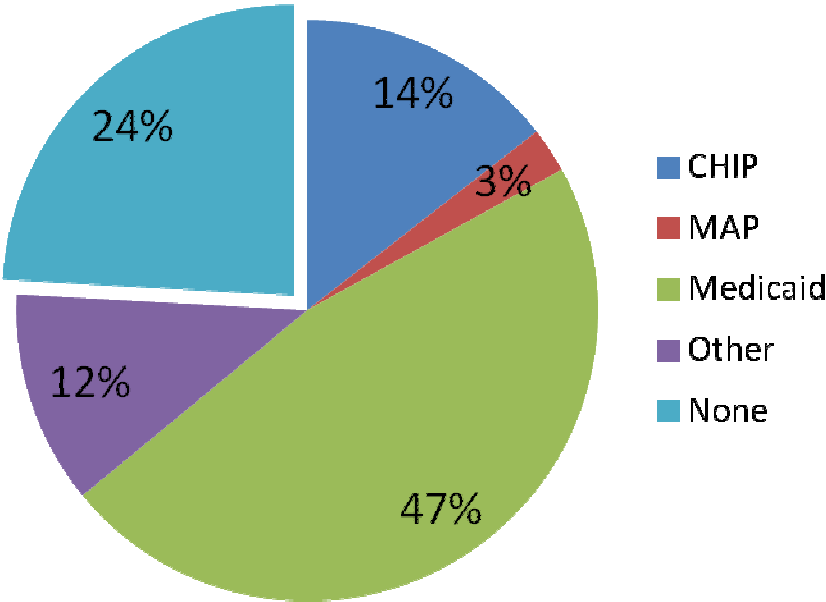

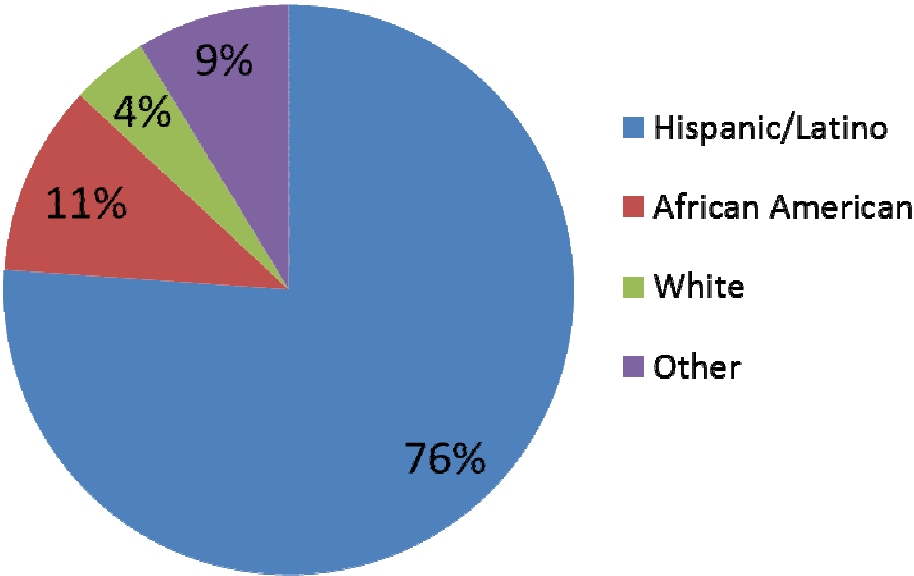

Insurance Type of Children Treated by Dental Program 2012-13



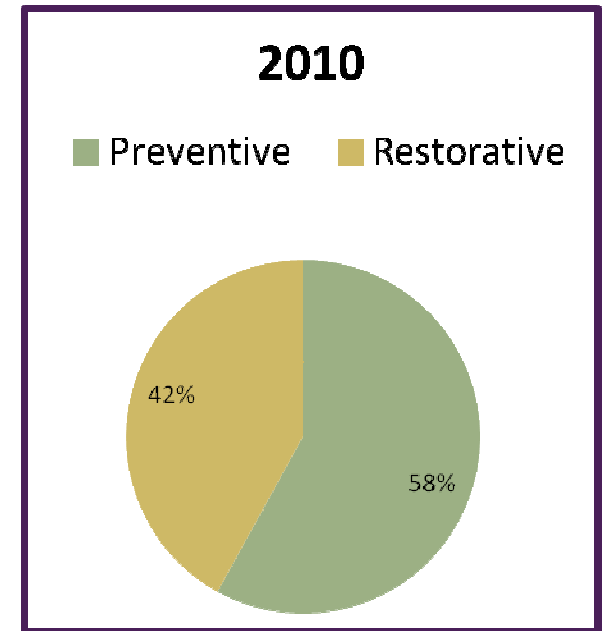
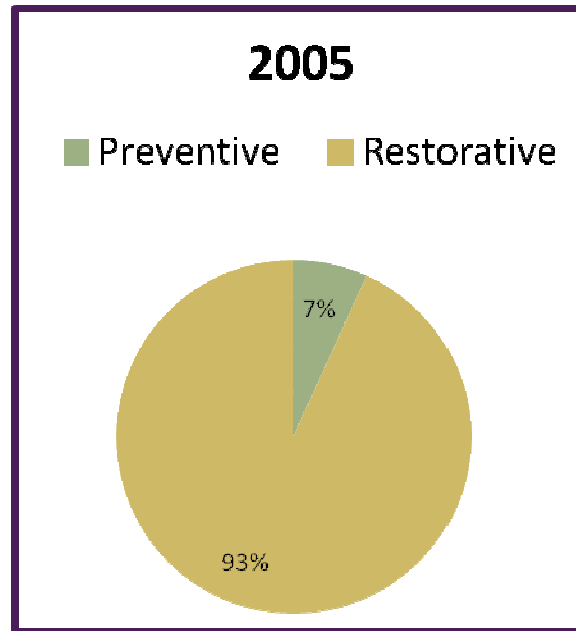
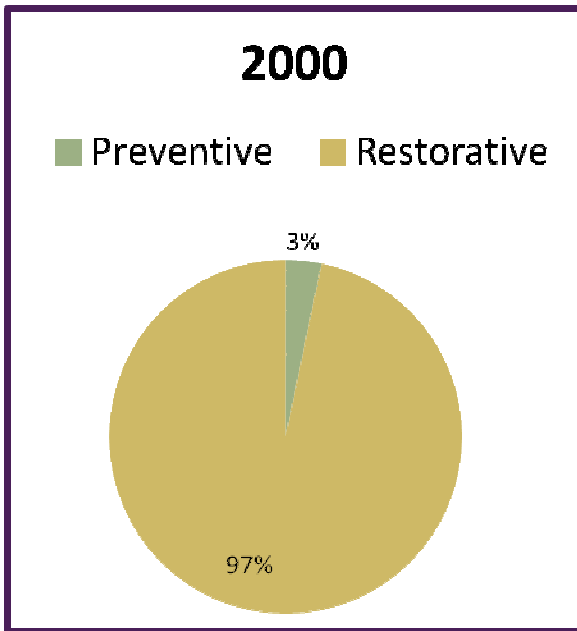
Race/Ethnicity of Children Served 2012-13 Breakdown

Findings of Outcome Evaluation

- Less Dental Decay
- Less Need for Referral to Program



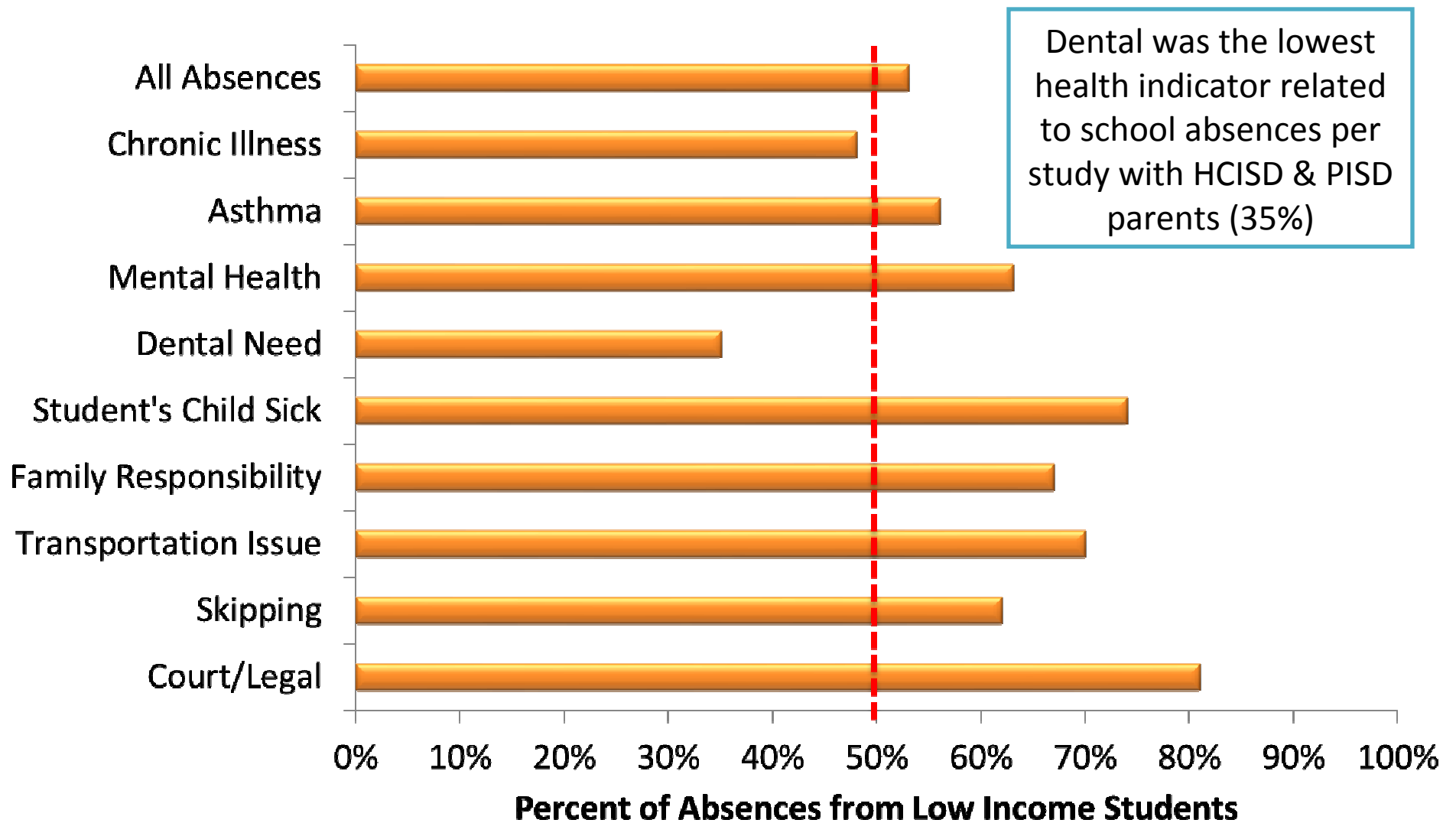
- Need More Serious Restorations

One Year Later:



- Less Dental Decay
- Less Need for Referral to Program
- Fewer Visits Needed
- Fewer Fillings (Restorative Treatment)
- More Sealants (Prevention)
- Fewer Procedures Overall
- Less Expensive Treatment
