




## Status of Oral Health in California

- Effective preventive measures are underutilized


# California Oral Health Plan 2018-2028

  - Capitalizes on recent fiscal developments








# **Tooth Decay in Children**



Percentage of kindergarteners in public schools in San Francisco with caries experience in their primary teeth by race/ethnicity, 2001-2012






