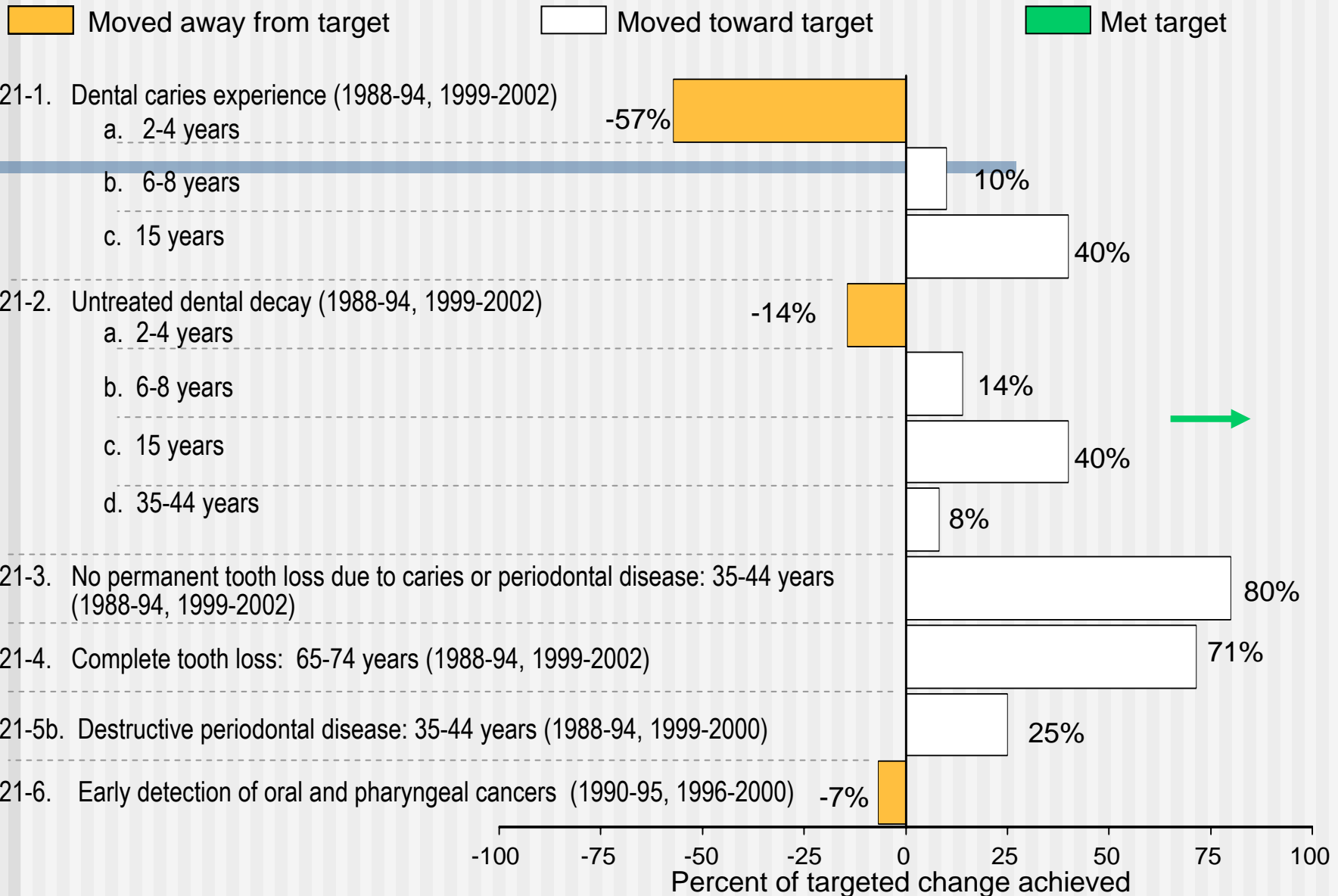

# Summary of Major Findings

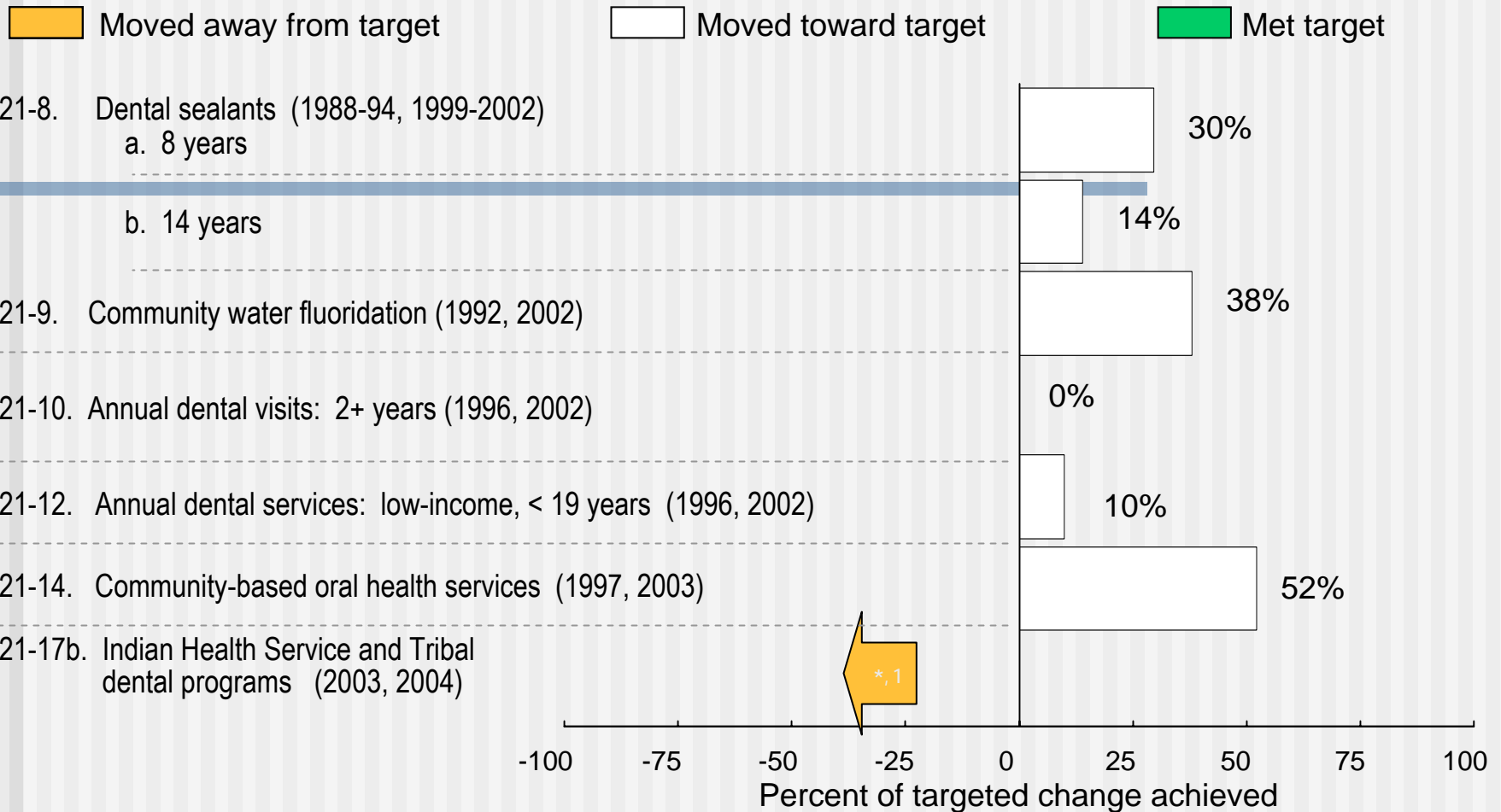
- No change in the prevalence and severity of dental caries in the primary dentition
- Caries in the permanent dentition continued to decline
- Large and important increase in the use of dental sealants
- Despite gains in dental caries, disparities associated with race/ethnicity, poverty status, level of education and smoking status remain

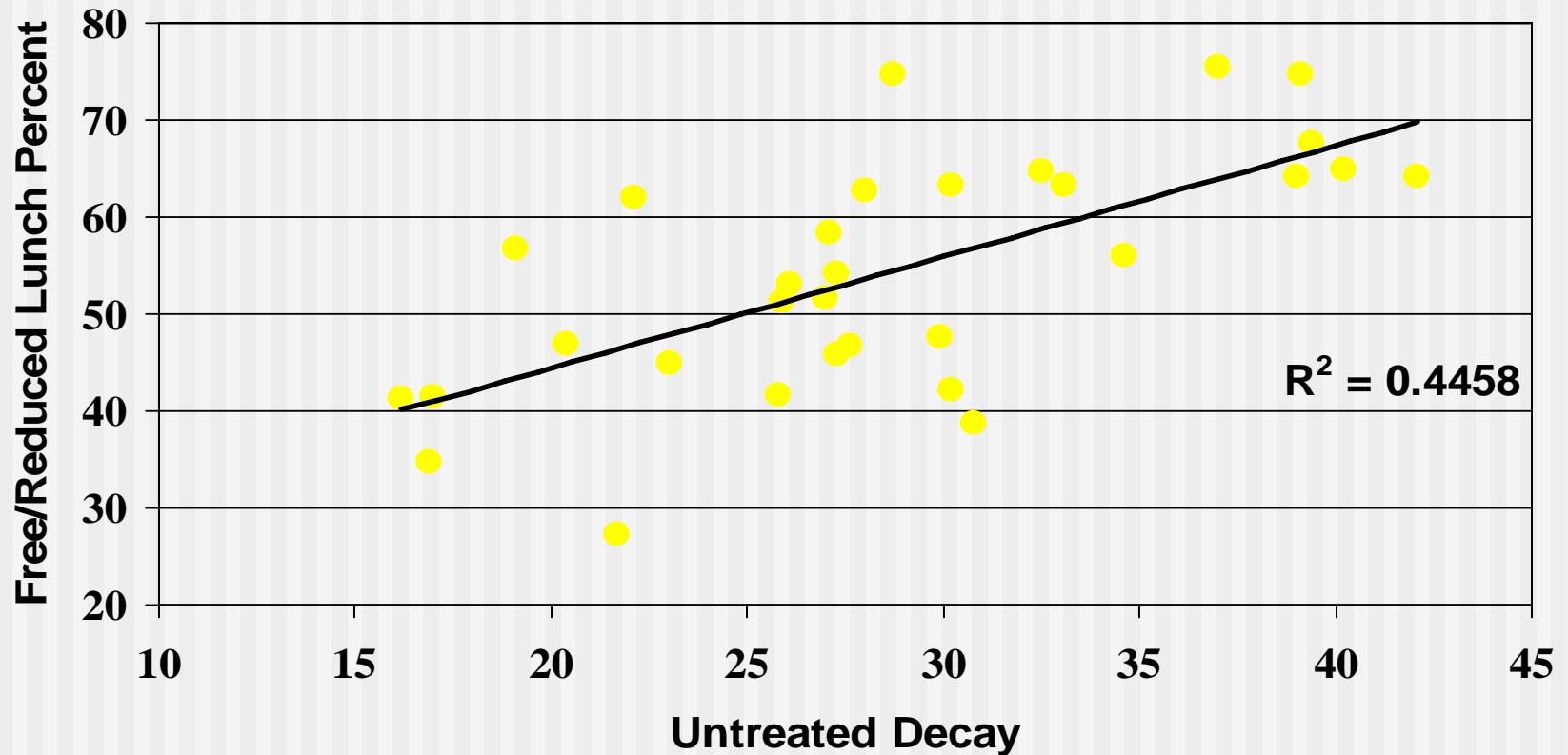
Years in parentheses represent the baseline data year and the most recent data year used to compute the percent of the Healthy People 2010 target achieved.

$$\text{Percent of targeted change achieved} = \left( \frac{\text{Most recent value} - \text{baseline value}}{\text{Year 2010 target} - \text{baseline value}} \right) \times 100$$

\* Percent of target achieved cannot be calculated.

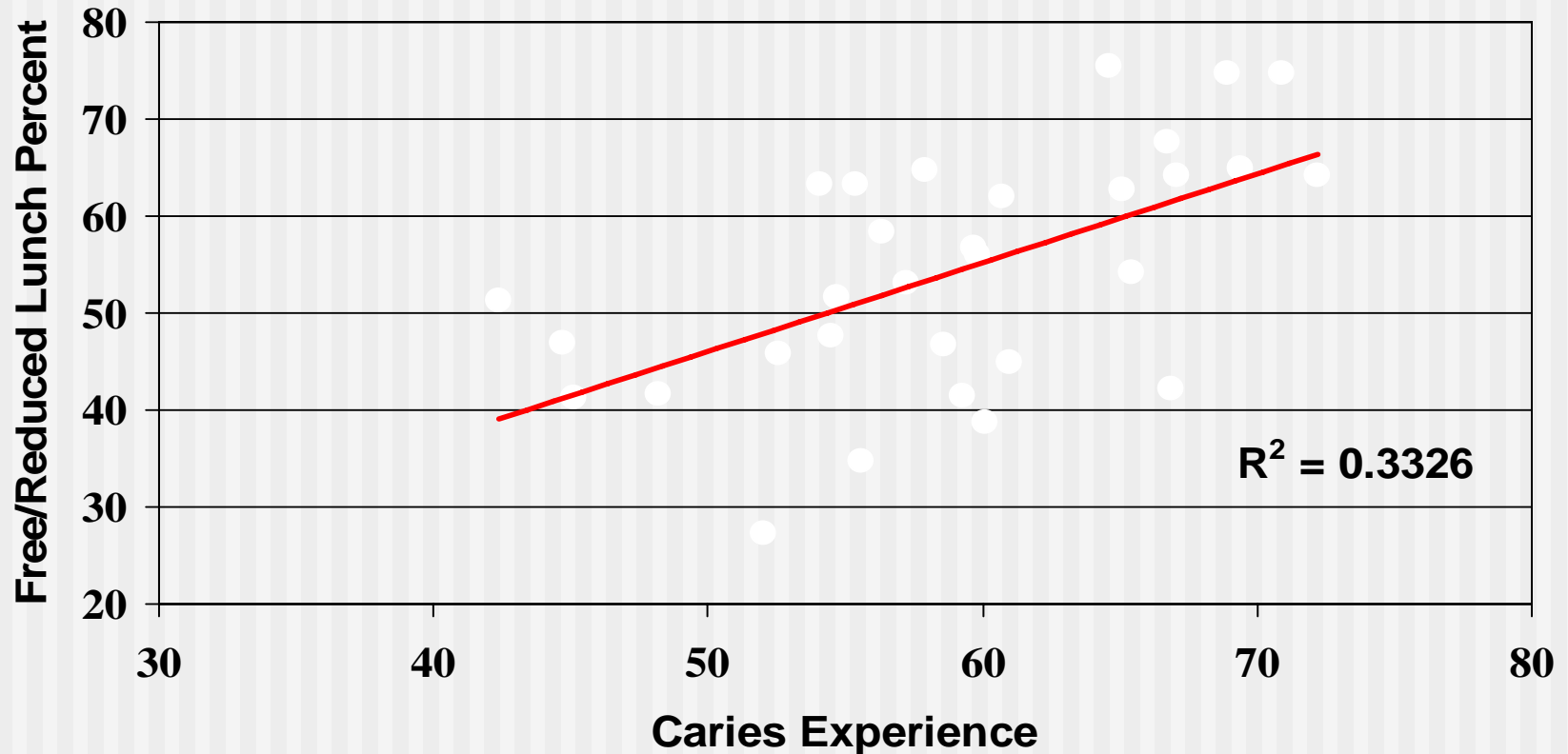

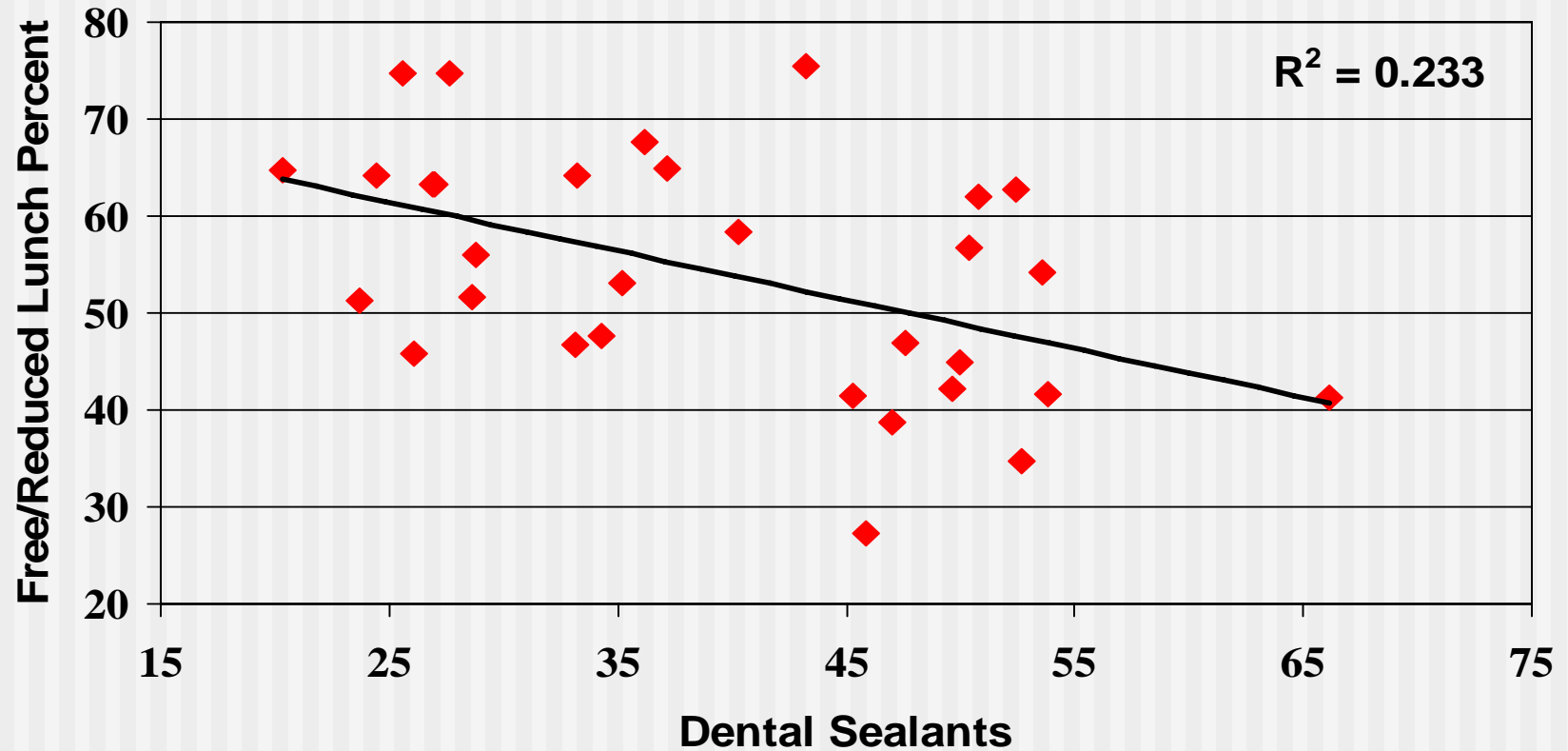




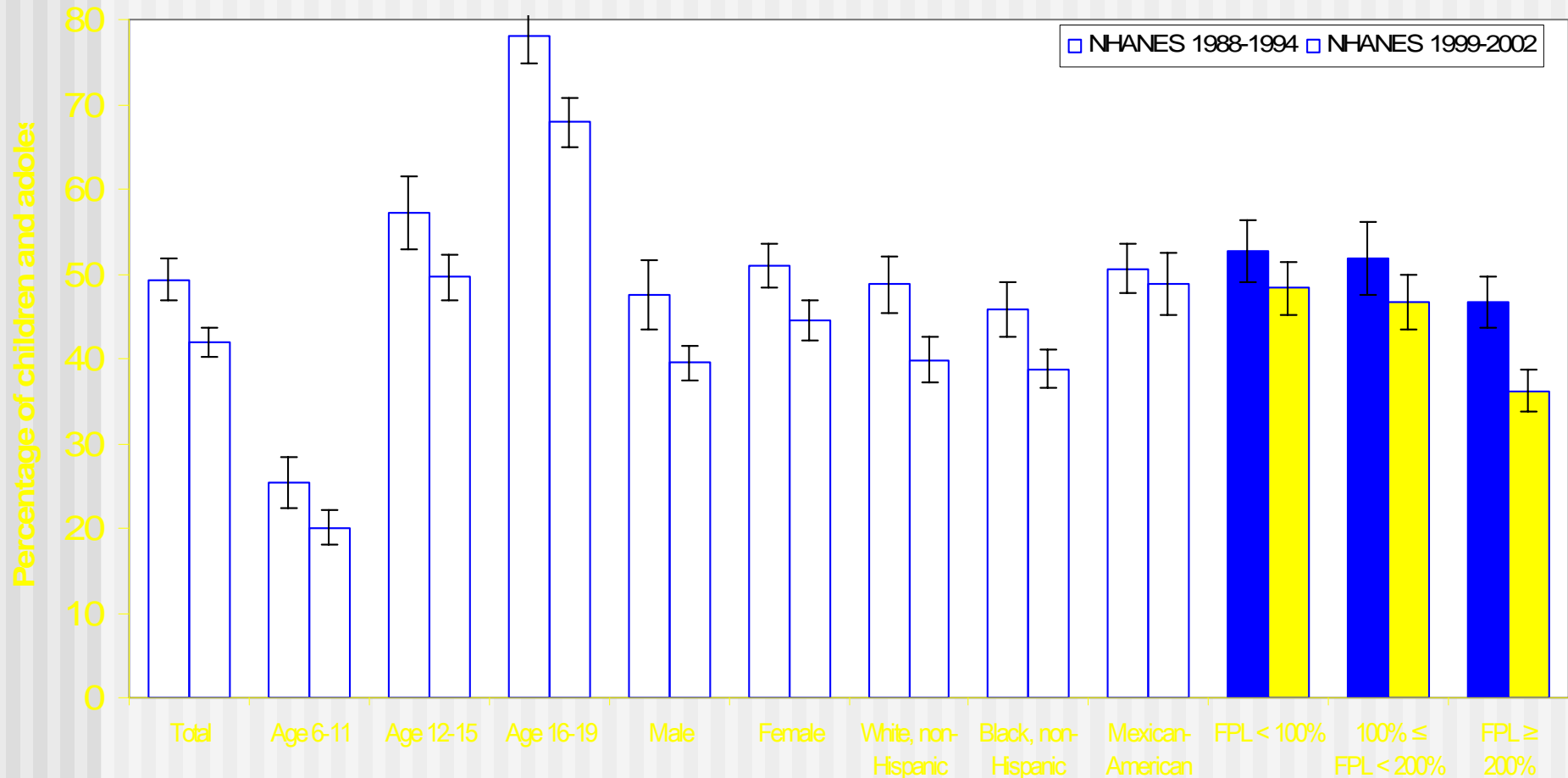
