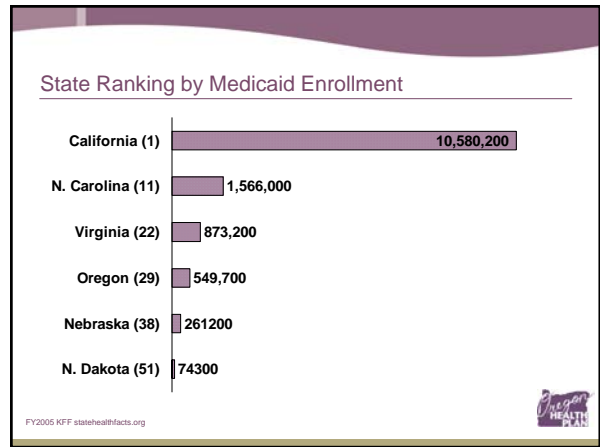
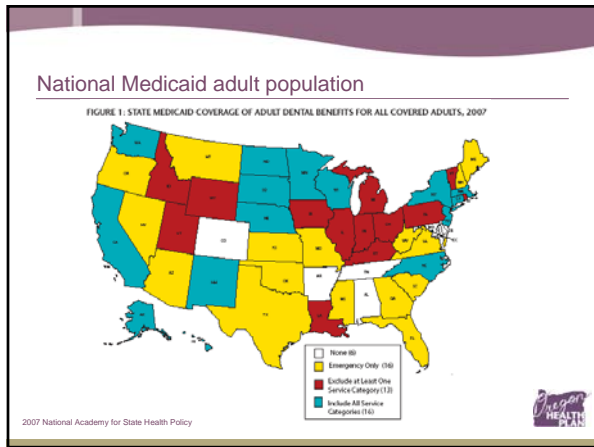

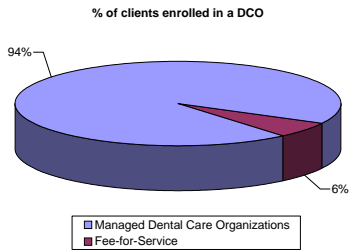


OHP Prioritized List — 680 Lines

Line	Diagnostic/Treatment pairs
59	Urgent and emergent dental services
105	Preventive (e.g., cleaning/fluoride)
324	Cleft palate with cleft lip (orthodontics)
357	Basic restorative (e.g., dental caries, fractured tooth)
474	Space and periodontal maintenance
499	Stabilization of periodontal health, complex restorative and removable prosthetics
503	Funding Line
505	Periodontics and complex prosthetics
630	Cosmetic dental services
660	Conditions where treatment results in marginal improvement and elective

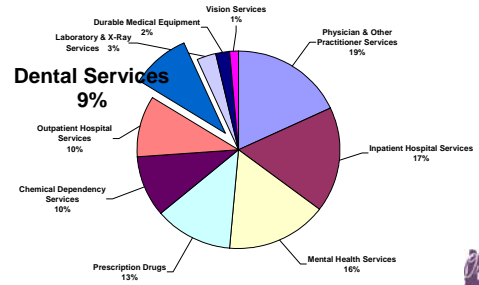
Oregon – A managed care state

Quality Improvement (QI) monitoring of managed care plans

- Annual on-site visits – allows collaboration and "real-time" quality improvement
- 2009 Focus: Quality improvement tool
 - Utilization management
 - Grievances
 - Access monitoring
- Overall program review
 - Outstanding issues
- External Quality Review Organization (EQRO)

Continuously enrolled members (320 days +) receiving at least 1 preventive dental service

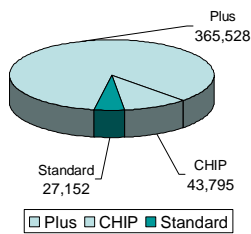
