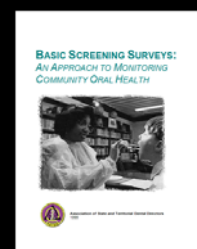

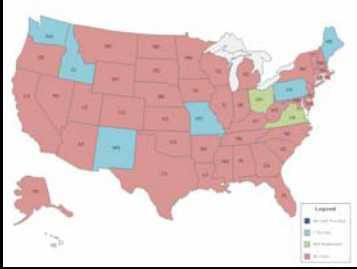

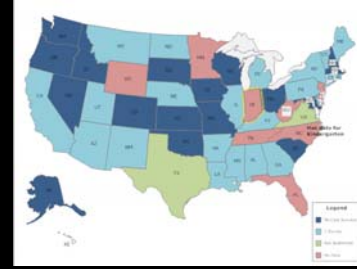


2000 States with 3rd Grade BSS Data

2009 States with 3rd Grade BSS Data

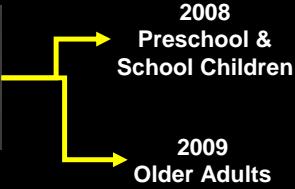

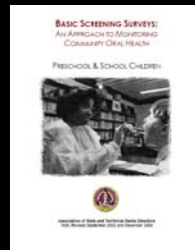
