- Dental caries was a very serious problem in the 40s
 - WW II requirement of 6 opposing teeth had to be waived very early
 - 40% of all WW II draftees required immediate treatment for the relief of pain
 - The typical school child developed 3-4 new carious lesions each year

US Supreme Court rules government lacks authority to regulate tobacco as an addictive drug.

US Congress passes legislation giving the FDA regulation over tobacco products.

Fluoridation Additives Cost

Higher in 2010 but cost of all water treatment additives have increased.

Cost is in line with Consumer Price Index
