Surveillance tools

■ ASTDD 7 Step Model

Needs Assessment
Systems Development/Access
(%) of children under age 19 years at or below 200% of FPL who receive preventive dental services
% of children that have visited a dentist during the previous year
Risk Reduction
% of children who use the oral health care system each year

Colorado 2010 Objective: Increase the percent of Medicaid-eligible children who receive dental services to 44.0 percent.

Data are for state fiscal year 2009. The Colorado percent is 43.7 percent.

Meeting the Colorado 2010 Target	100% of the target	≥ 44.0
Close to the Colorado 2010 Target	80% - 99% of the target	35.2 - 43.9
At Some Distance from the Colorado 2010 Target	51 - 79% of the target	21.9 - 35.1
Far From the Colorado 2010 Target	≤ 50% of the target	≤ 22.0
